勞工及福利局局長到訪東華三院包兆龍護理安老院

勞工及福利局局長羅致光博士GBS太平紳士及勞工及福利局副局長徐英偉太平紳士,於6月5日到訪東華三院包<mark>兆龍</mark>護理安老院,參觀了多項設施和服務,包括有助提升情緒健康的智能海豹、嶄新的肢體復康器材,以及為加强對有不同認知能力及體

能程度院友的個人化照顧而推行的「小區管理」模式。在參觀中,羅局長更體驗 了對認知障礙症患者有懷緬治療效果的模擬墟市活動「趁墟樂逍遙」。

探訪期間,羅局長與院友、院友親屬及職員面談,討論「小區管理」模式的成效,了解各小區內的一站式護理及起居照顧服務,不但強化院方的全人照顧, 亦加強了職員與院友及院友親屬的互信關係。

Dr. the Hon. LAW Chi Kwong, GBS, JP, Secretary for Labour and Welfare, and Mr. TSUI Ying Wai, Caspar, JP, Under Secretary for Labour and Welfare, visited TWGHs Pao Siu Loong Care & Attention Home on 5 June 2018. They toured several facilities and services at the Home, including an intelligent toy seal that helps enhance mental health, advanced rehabilitative equipment for upper and lower limbs, as well as the Small Group Home model aiming to enhance customised care services for elderly according to their level of cognitive and physical power. Hon. LAW Chi Kwong took part in the simulation activity "Fun-filled Nostalgic Theme Park" which provided demented elders with Reminiscence Therapy effects.

During the visit, Dr. the Hon. LAW Chi Kwong had discussions with the residents and their relatives, as well as staff members, to understand more about the effectiveness of the Small Group Home model, as well as how the one-stop nursing and personal care services at each unit enhanced the Home's holistic personal care, and the trust among staff members, residents and their relatives.

「愛不同藝術」「藝術統合X智能障礙」工作坊

東華三院「愛不同藝術」去年曾邀得臺北市藝術統合教育研究會資深特殊藝術教育家及舞蹈家林絲緞來港,舉辦「藝術統合X智能障礙」工作坊,為本院復康服務員工進行為期兩天的講座及分享,由於反應熱烈,今年再度邀請林絲緞來港,為復康院友提供訓練課程。

為期8天的工作坊內容包括由林絲緞創立的「動作教育」及「舞蹈療癒」部分,亦有專為自閉症學員和體弱輪椅院友設計、藉着身體舞動而啟發的能力訓練。工作坊吸引了逾80人次參加,包括復康院友及復康服務員工,這除為業界、服務對象和工作人員帶來啟發外,還締造了分享實踐經驗的良機。



"Integrated Arts x Mental Retardation" Workshops of i-dArt

TWGHs i-dArt invited Ms. LIN Si Duan, an experienced educator of special arts education and dancer from The Integrated Arts Education Association of Taipei, to Hong Kong last year for 2-day talks and sharing sessions for TWGHs rehabilitation service staff. Due to the overwhelming response, i-dArt made invitation to her to come to Hong Kong again this year to organise "Integrated Arts x Mental Retardation" Workshops and provide training for rehabilitation service users.

The 8-day workshops consisted of "movement education" and "dance therapy" established by Ms. LIN. There were also trainings specifically designed for people with Autism Spectrum Disorder and the frail ones on wheelchairs. The workshops drew over 80 people to join, including rehabilitation service users and service providers. This programme not only inspired the participants, but also provided an opportunity for them to put what they have learnt into practice.

Programme provides professional training to youths who are interested in the multimedia industry, including digital commercial photography, microfilm production, graphic design, script writing, and professional makeup.
