主席感言

The quadrennial World Cup was held this July. People in Hong Kong and even around the world were thrilled by the soccer fever. Men and women, seniors and juniors, people from different backgrounds came together and devoted themselves to the event, cheering and rooting for their favourite teams. The charm of football is self-evident. In the 2015/2016 academic year, TWGHs launched the "Joint Primary Schools Soccer Ambassador Programme", which infuses students with elements of moral education through football training and friendly matches during overseas visits, so as to foster their good character and spirit. In early July this year, I led a trip with 42 "Soccer Ambassadors" to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. In just 5 days, I witnessed how our little "Soccer Ambassadors" at the U10 and the U12 levels kept improving themselves in the intensive training and cultural exchange activities. It was really gratifying to see how they not only grew up and broadened their horizons, but also became more confident and independent.

The development of students' personal potential requires not only their own efforts but also good mentorship. This year, 5 teachers from 3 TWGHs schools have been presented the Chief Executive's Award for Teaching Excellence. Congratulations to them! Our teaching teams are committed to enhancing education effectiveness through advancing the design and contents of their teaching. They also strive to develop and strengthen students' creative thinking, problem-solving ability and perseverance. Their selfless dedication to nurturing the next generation really deserves our admiration and applause!

A series of favourable news on campus keep coming to us are really uplifting. SZE Ho Fung, a Secondary Six student of TWGHs Wong Fut Nam College, obtained excellent results of four 5**, two 5* and one 4 in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE). Born with language impairment, SZE made the aspiring achievement with his perseverance in academic pursuit and his love for science. His success is also owed to the care and support of TWGHs schools, which arranged speech therapies for SZE, appointed him to different duties on campus and encouraged him to take part in extra-curricular activities, so as to help him improve communication and English skills. His teachers also recommended science-related activities and courses to him, for the purpose of enhancing his knowledge and helping him realise his dream in the science realm. SZE's outstanding development today not only makes us proud, but also highlights TWGHs philosophy of "Education for All". It is our firm conviction that given appropriate training and support, students with different backgrounds can all develop their strengths and enjoy a bright future of their own.

Meanwhile, at the "Prize Presentation Ceremony for Student of the Year Award cum HKDSE Outstanding Awards" in mid-July, 96 students were commended for their outstanding performance in academic fields, morality, sports and/or arts, in addition to 32 students with brilliant results in this year's HKDSE. Seeing the joyful smiles of students, teachers and parents at the Ceremony, I am even more convinced that good and equal education is an important cornerstone of the long-term development of our society. TWGHs always holds fast to this mission and never forgets why we started.

Summer vacation has already begun, besides getting prepared for the new school year, it is also a good time for our students to explore and gain new knowledge and experience. TWGHs schools have launched a number of activities at home and abroad for students for the vacation, including study tours, which have attracted more than 5,000 participants during the year.
