

## 發展背景

東華三院的中醫服務由1870年開始至今，歷史悠久，致力「救病承危」。為配合政府的中醫藥發展政策，我們推行了一連串的中醫服務發展計劃，包括與本地大學及醫院管理局合作，成立以醫、教、研為主的中醫藥中心，以實踐循證為本的中醫藥臨床科研去提供優良的中醫專科醫療服務。本院於1997年和香港大學簽署合作備忘錄，致力共同發展中醫藥服務。

東華三院 - 香港大學中醫診所暨教研中心(中西區)(前名為東華醫院 香港大學中醫藥臨床教研中心)於2002年成立，為全港第一間非政府機構、醫院管理局及本地大學，以三方協作的模式成立的中醫教研中心。

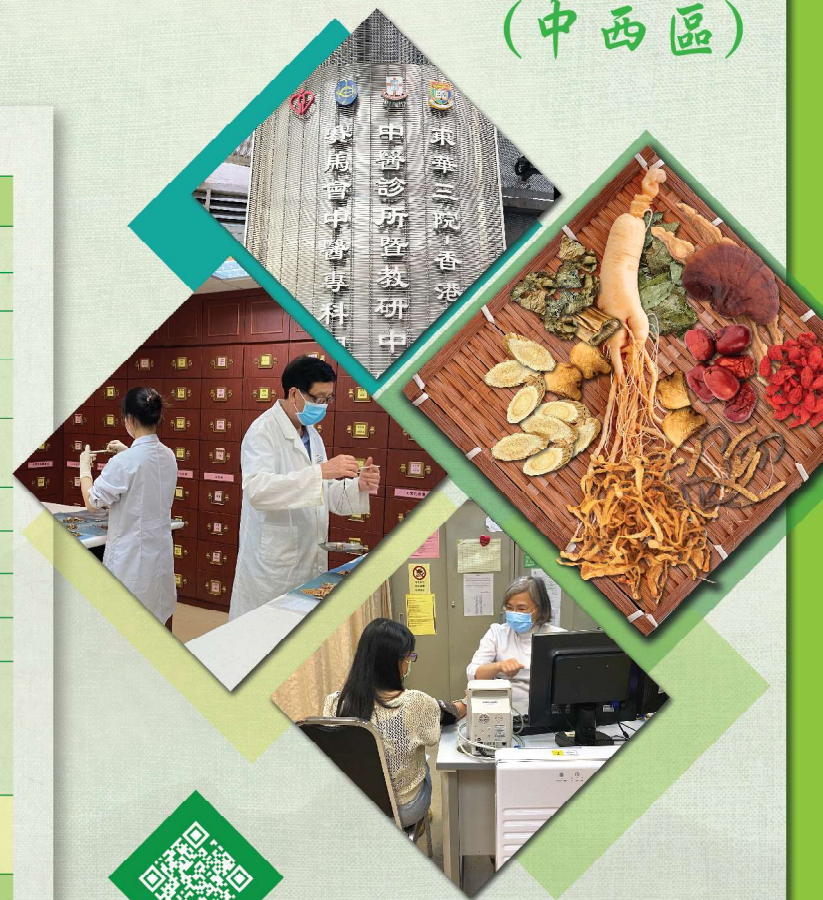

## Background

Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs) have been providing Chinese medicine services since 1870. We strive “to heal the sick and to relieve the distressed”. To align with the Chinese medicine policy of the Government, we collaborate with local universities and the Hospital Authority (HA) to establish Chinese medicine service centres. We aim at providing high-quality Chinese medicine specialist services and promoting evidence-based clinical researches. With the signing of Memorandum of Understanding between TWGHs and The University of Hong Kong (HKU) in 1997, we determined to contribute to the development of Chinese medicine in Hong Kong.



Tung Wah Group of Hospitals – The University of Hong Kong Chinese Medicine Clinic cum Training and Research Centre (Central & Western District) (formerly named as Tung Wah Hospital - The University of Hong Kong Clinical Centre for Teaching and Research in Chinese Medicine) was established in 2002. It is the first Chinese Medicine Centre for Training and Research operated under the tripartite collaboration modal involving a non-governmental organization, HA and a local university in Hong Kong.

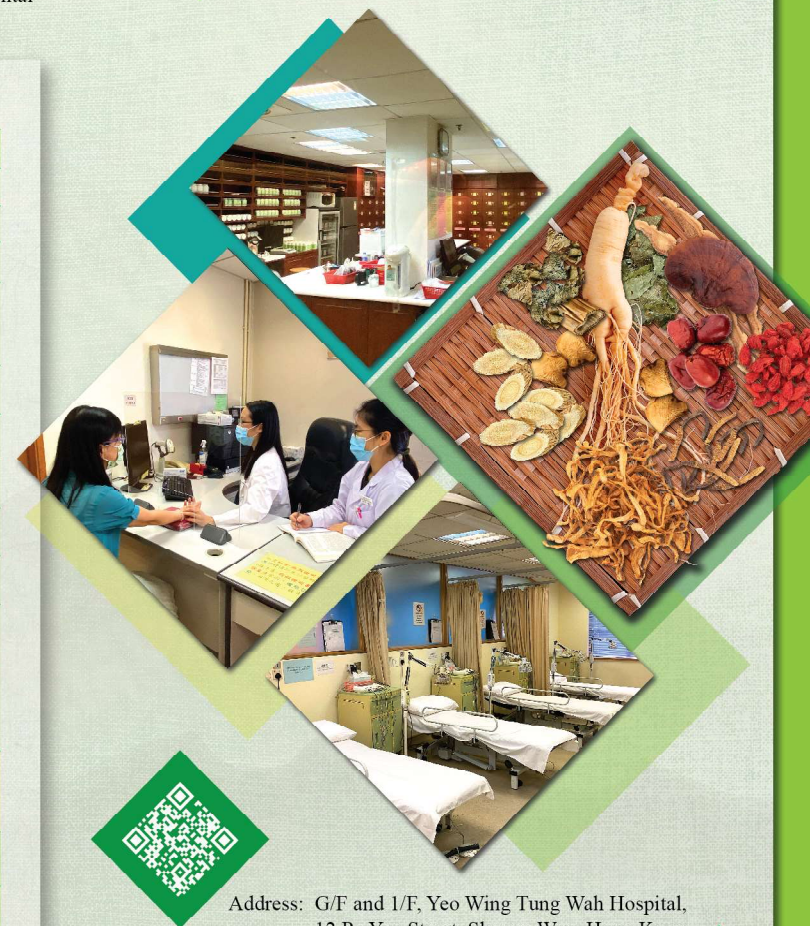
